



OFFICIAL RULES

Hands on a Hyundai is a physical endurance competition sponsored by Chris Crain Hyundai and First Community Bank where one hand must remain on vehicle at all times. The final remaining contestant (first place winner) will win the vehicle and the second, third and fourth place winners will receive cash as it states herein.

Prizes are as follows:

- First Place – a 2026 Hyundai Santa Cruz
- Second Place - \$2,500
- Third Place - \$1,500
- Fourth Place - \$1,000

The contest will begin at noon on Thursday, April 30, 2026, at Oak and Parkway in downtown Conway and will be a part of the Toad Suck Daze Festival May 1-3, 2026. The event will continue until there is a winner.

Contestants will be selected in a random drawing and those selected will be announced on the Hands on a Hyundai Facebook page on dates listed below.

One registration can be made per day at any of the following locations.

- First Community Bank locations in Conway, Little Rock, Beebe, Searcy, and Cabot
- Chris Crain Dealerships – Conway, Hot Springs, and Benton
- Chris Crain Customs – Conway
- Chris Crain Collision Center – Conway

Multiple contest entries per day will result in disqualification.

Registration will begin on Monday, March 23, 2026. Three names will be randomly drawn daily Monday through Friday from March 30, 2026, through April 22, 2026, and announced via Facebook on the Hands on a Hyundai Facebook Page. Each name drawn (aka qualifier) will have 48 hours from the time of the announcement to appear in person at the Chris Crain Hyundai dealership in Conway, Arkansas during regular store hours to complete paperwork and have photo taken to qualify for the contest. A contestant selection event will be held on Friday, April 24, at the Chris Crain Hyundai in Conway at 6 pm. At this time 22 contestants and two alternates will be selected for the event via random drawing. Qualifiers must be present at selection event to be included in the drawing for the final contestant pool.

All contestants must sign a Participant Agreement, Waiver, and Release of Liability prior to the start of the event and the terms of the same are incorporated herein.

All contestants must agree for their name, image, and likeness to be used in promotion of the event and future promotion at the discretion of Chris Crain Hyundai or First Community Bank.

Only one member of an immediate family is allowed as a contestant.

Contestants must have a valid real ID Arkansas driver's license and be 18 years or older by Thursday, April 30, 2026.

All judge's rulings are final.

No sitting, leaning, or squatting is permitted while on the vehicle.

No eating or drinking is permitted while on the vehicle.

Tobacco use or vaping while on the vehicle is prohibited.

The excretion of bodily fluids while on the vehicle is prohibited.

No profanity or harassment will be allowed by contestants or their pit crew upon judges, bystanders, other contestants. Such actions will result in an immediate ejection of the contestant and contest disqualification.

Contestants agree to submit to a urine test immediately preceding the beginning of the contest to ensure illegal, non-prescribed drugs are not being used. A second such test will be performed when only three remaining contestants are in the contest. In the event a contestant tests positive for illegal, non-prescribed drugs, the contestant shall be immediately disqualified from the contest.

Contestants will be given the following:

- An event T-Shirt to be worn at all times during the event. A new shirt will be given out every 24 hours
- A pair of gloves to be worn throughout their time on the vehicle and a new pair will be given out every 24 hours
- A five-minute break every hour of the competition
- A 15-minute break every six hours of the competition
- A 10' X 10' secured space in the pit area for personal items
- Two passes to be used for people assisting them ("pit crew") in the competition (only contestants, pit crews, and event staff will be allowed into the pit area)
- Blood pressure and heart rate checks every six hours by certified emergency medical technicians. Medical personnel will advise contestants of their condition and discuss issues if present. It will be the contestant's decision whether to remain or remove themselves from the contest based on results.

Contestants must provide all food and drinks for themselves.

The winner of the 2026 Hyundai Santa Cruz will receive a 10-99 MISC for the dealer purchase price of the automobile and be responsible for any sales and income tax due. The second, third, and fourth place winners will receive at 10-99 MISC for the amount of their winnings.

The winner must keep the vehicle without selling or transferring to a third-party for 90 days with logos remaining on the vehicle.

Immediate family of Chris Crain Enterprises and First Community Bank and their employees are not allowed to enter the competition.

In case of severe weather contestants will be removed from the vehicle to a more secure location.
